

CLARK & POUGNAUD A SENSE OF BLISS

Opening Reception with the Artists: Saturday, December 9, 2023 Exhibition dates: Dec. 9, 2023 – Feb. 10, 2024


Galerie XII Los Angeles is pleased to announce A SENSE OF BLISS, the new exhibition by the French artist duo Clark and Pougnaud, opening on December 2, 2023. Some works from their iconic series will be exhibited alongside new pieces.



Since the 1990s, Clark and Pougnaud have formed a duo with a wellestablished modus operandi. Revealed by their project «Hommage à Hopper» which earned them the HSBC and the Archimboldo awards, the artists merge their two techniques into a theatrical aesthetic. If their images may seem like simple portraits, they are actually strange and sophisticated settings. Over the years, the decors have been stripped to summarize the essential. With the series *Eden, A Season in Paradise*, exhibited in particular in Chaumont-sur-Loire in 2021-2022, they began a break away from post-production techniques to favor the shooting of installations. *Fetish* (2020-2021) inspired by heterogeneous collections of objects, continues this research in a post-surrealist aesthetic.

Clark and Pougnaud create moods more than they create images. They invite us to a dreamlike walk, to contemplation, to the exploration of our own imagination in a society that turns at full speed.

BIOGRAPHY



Clark and Pougnaud, are a couple of French artists, respectively painter and photographer. Pougnaud, from a family of artists, has since her early age rubbed shoulders with the world of art. Clark arew up in the world of photography. He was his father's assistant before opening his own studio in the 1980s. It was in the 1990s that they formed their duet: Pougnaud thinks the staging, manufactures and paints the sets, Clark photographs liahts and them. Their work reflects a sinaular transversality: painting, model sets and photographs. Their work is resolutely contemporary,

through the technique used, the choice of characters, the solid colors and the acute sense of staging. Their approach is also deeply crossed by pictorial references of the twentieth century, like Edward Hopper, René Magritte and surrealism. In 2000, Clark and Pougnaud were awarded the Arcimboldo Prize for Digital Creation, followed by an exhibition at the Maison Européenne de la Photographie in Paris, and in 2006, the HSBC Prize for Photography.
